

Thank you for inquiring about Dance Gallery. Our centrally located facility has SIX newly remodeled dance studios, all with sprung floor systems. Our experienced staff of more than ten teachers offers a diverse curriculum for all ages and levels. Class sizes are limited to a manageable number to ensure each student receives quality instruction.

Dance Gallery has a very reputable and qualified staff teaching in all forms of dance. We are sure that Dance Gallery will exceed your expectations. Listed in this schedule are classes developed to build basic dance technique up to the most skilled dancers. If you are just beginning your study of dance, or are looking for a pre-professional dance program, Dance Gallery can find a suitable program for you.

Students enrolled at Dance Gallery will progress to become proficient dancers, and with determination and hard work, Dance Gallery students can continue into a professional based program, or apply to colleges for dance majors. Past Dance Gallery students have been accepted into the Royal Winnipeg Ballet School, the Rock School, JKO Ballet Intensive, and School of American Ballet (summer).

The schedule displayed in this brochure offers options for dance students 10 years and older. To enroll in classes, it is necessary to attend our formal registration at Dance Gallery. At that time, you will be asked to complete a carbon copy registration form, and submit it to the Dance Gallery office with the registration fee, and trimester tuition.

Registration dates: June 16, 18, 23, 24, 25, and August 11, 12, 13, - 2:00-7:00 PM. For registration in July, go to our website for a listing of the office hours.

Classes begin the day after Labor Day.

ADMINISTRATION POLICIES

Registration fee(s) and first three months of tuition must be received to be considered enrolled and space reserved in the dance classes. In extreme circumstances, Dance Gallery will assist you in developing a payment plan for your family, although our billing system will be based on a trimester schedule. Payments due during the following weeks..

- 1st payment due at the time of registration
 - 2nd payment due Nov 30-Dec. 5th, 2009
 - 3rd payment and recital fees due March 1-6
- Because we limit our enrollment, Dance Gallery has certain payment expectations.
- Tuition is expected to be paid in full by the end of the first week listed above to keep your space in class.
 - Two weeks before the trimester payment is due, you will receive a bill and any information needed to keep you updated on the studio calendar of events.
 - Dance Gallery does not pro-rate, refund, or credit for missed classes, although we encourage dancers take "make-up" classes for missed classes.
 - Dance Gallery accepts cash, checks, VISA and Master Card

DRESS CODE FOR BALLET CLASS

Ballet (girls): Solid black simple leotard, pink footed tights, & pink leather or canvas ballet slippers. Skirts are optional for some classes at the teacher's discretion. No skirts, shirts, or leg warmers in any ballet classes. Hair must be in a secure bun. Short hair needs to be secured away from the face.

Ballet (boys): White or black t-shirt, black tights or fitted leggings, dance belt, black leather or canvas ballet slippers. ***Ballet slippers should fit like a sock, but not so tight that the toes curl up***

DRESS CODE FOR OTHER CLASSES

Students enrolled in **Tap, Jazz, Hip Hop, Lyrical, Modern, Broadway or Liturgical** will need tights, a leotard, and appropriate shoes. Students may wear dance shorts with tights and a leotard, but no boxer shorts allowed. We request that students do not wear jazz pants for jazz, modern or lyrical, as teachers need to see their knees for technique purposes. A ballet class leotard will work well in any class. Bare legs and exposed stomachs are NEVER allowed in any Dance Gallery classes! Boys-tight fitting jazz pants, shirt, shoes.

Adult Dance Classes: Dancers should wear a solid colored leotard, tights or leggings (so the instructor can see the knees), and appropriate shoes for the class you are enrolled. A skirt may be worn for the ballet class, and jazz pants for tap and jazz.

DRESS CODE DANCE SHOES

- Ballet - leather or canvas with elastics sewn across the top of the arch. Should fit like a sock
- Pointe Shoes - do not purchase your pointe shoes without the guidance of a Dance Gallery instructor. If you are enrolled in a pointe class for the first time, the teacher will contact you to arrange a fitting.
- Broadway - black jazz shoes
- Lyrical - modern dance thongs or bare feet
- Jazz - black jazz shoes
- Tap - low heeled black tap shoes
- Hip Hop - black dance tennis shoes (available at Danceline on Minnesota Avenue)
- Liturgical - pink ballet slippers

OTHER DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

- No street clothing of ANY kind.
- Hair must be worn away from face. Ballet students must wear hair in a bun.
- For safety reasons, no jewelry or watches.
